



Student Expectations

All students are expected to follow these guidelines:

Students will:

- use the school values as the foundation of everything they do:
Respect, Honesty, Persistence and Personal Best.
- be polite and respectful in their dealings with all members of the Jeparit Primary School community.
- follow the School Expectations, as set out in the diaries.
- attend school every day, unless a written note or a medical certificate is provided to explain their absence.
- be punctual to class and school.
- assemble any time the bell is rung.
- begin lessons as soon as instructed.
- use the diary to write down due dates for homework. A note in the student diary will indicate if a student has been particularly good or if they have done something wrong and parents will initial this note to show that they have seen it.
- leave the room as they found it ensuring things are put away.
- wear our school uniform
- leave the kitchen area tidy
- be excited about learning
- ask questions whenever you are unsure
- expect courtesy and care from teachers at all times
- speak to any teacher if something is worrying them

Students will NOT:

- prevent others from learning. Students who do not comply with this requirement will follow a three-step process.
 - First, they will be given a warning,
 - then moved to another seat,
 - then given a detention for being disruptive.
- go to the toilet during class time unless there are extenuating circumstances.
- talk when others are addressing the class.
- leave the school grounds without written permission from their parent or guardian.
